Joubert and Nivelt designer has created a strength line mono-hull with incredible shape. All the know-how of the French yard sums up in this vessel.

Insulated for warm/cold seas and sound with 5cm of Styrodur up to 50 cm below the floating line. Delivered in 2002, this Center board vessel is also very performant cloth to the wind and accept to be pushed back to the wind due to his speed hull.

Full painted deck and new teak in 2016, this **Garcia 70** benefits from a full equipment for all type of navigations. Nothing has been missed.

Inside accommodations has been created in pear wood which give all the quality of this 4 cabins.
